A Simple Way To Give Smarter

A Charitable Gift Annuity is a simple agreement between you and Texas Boys Ranch Foundation, in which you receive a regular payment for life based on the value of the gift and your age when you make the gift. You can transfer appreciated stocks, a maturing CD, or even simply write a check. This simple agreement can be for the lifetime of one person, or even two! And once you make your gift, you can count on a reliable stream of payments that won't fluctuate through the years. Current rates based on sample donor ages are listed in the chart below for a Two-Life Charitable Gift Annuity:

17	AGES	CURRENT RATE
	65/70	4.0%
	70/75	4.3%
	75/80	4.9%
	80/85	5.8%


